3. **Winslow Holmer:** American artist, he chose watercolor as his prime means of expressions
4. **Luminosity:** brightness
5. **Wash:** color mixed with water
6. **Ream of paper:** 500 sheets
7. **How is paper weight determined?** the thickness and weight of paper is determined by how much a ream weighs.
8. **Hot Press Paper:** smooth
